# Purpose of the Role

The University of Portsmouth Hockey Club requires a coach to lead the Women's 1st team for the 2022-23 season. The successful candidate will be available to deliver regular training sessions from September 2022 - April 2023, and attend fixtures when scheduled throughout the season. The team currently plays in the 1A South Eastern BUCS league and plays regular fixtures.

Training sessions take place on Monday evenings, 6pm-8pm at Langstone Campus. Fixtures take place on Wednesday afternoons (times and locations vary).

# Main Responsibilities:

- Plan, deliver and evaluate weekly training sessions for the Women's 1st team members
- Attend fixtures and manage the Women's 1st team where possible
- Communicate regularly and effectively with the Women's Captain regarding team selection
- Support the club to plan and deliver a pre-season programme
- Promote the club's philosophy to all members
- Adhere to the University's Code of Conduct

- Essential: UKCC Level 2 in Coaching Hockey or UKCC England Hockey Coach qualification
- Essential: Previous coaching experience
- Desirable: Knowledge of hockey within higher education
