Purpose of the Role

The University of Portsmouth Women's Rugby Club are recruiting volunteer coaches to assist with the delivery of their training sessions and match days, alongside their Head Coach. The club consists of a team competing in the BUCS South Eastern Tier 2 league, and novice players looking to develop their skills.

Training sessions take place on:

- Mondays, 6.30pm – 8.00pm at HMS Temeraire, Portsmouth
- Fridays, 6.00pm – 7.30pm at HMS Temeraire, Portsmouth

Fixtures are scheduled for:

- Wednesday afternoons (times & locations vary).

Main Responsibilities

- Work collaboratively with the Head Coach to plan, deliver and evaluate weekly training sessions
- Attend team fixtures and assist in the delivery of match day warm-up, tactics, and cool down where possible
- Promote the club's philosophy to all members
- Adhere to the University's Code of Conduct

Criteria:

- Essential: Previous experience playing rugby
- Essential: Good organisation skills
- Essential: Good communication skills
- Desirable: England Rugby Coaching Award / Rugby Ready Award
- Desirable: An understanding of competitive rugby within Higher Education
