Purpose of the Role

Main Responsibilities

- Plan, deliver and evaluate weekly training sessions, in line with the club's playing philosophy, working collaboratively with assistant coaches / volunteers
- Attend team fixtures and manage the match-day squad where possible
- Communicate effectively with the Club / Team Captains to advise on team selection
- Promote the club's philosophy to all members
- Adhere to the University's Code of Conduct

Criteria:

- Essential: England Rugby Coaching Award Level 2
- Essential: Previous coaching experience
- Essential: Good organisation skills
- Essential: Good communication skills
- Desirable: UKCC Level 3: RFU Advanced Coaching Award (or working towards)
- Desirable: An understanding of competitive rugby within Higher Education
